be rooted in love, kindness, and service to others.

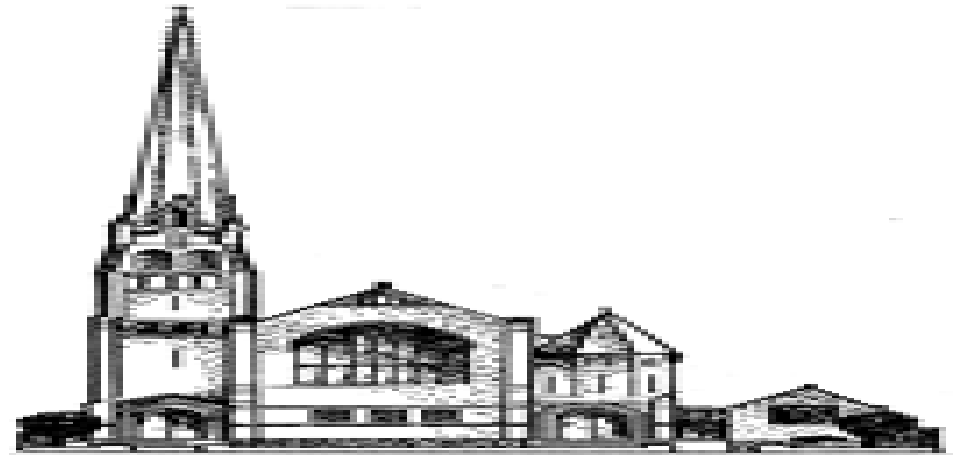
Help me recognize the opportunities to make a positive impact,
