

WEDNESDAY

Ask the Lord of the Church to revive our hearts, inspire our congregations and mobilise the Body of Christ at large with a renewed desire to proclaim his truth and demonstrate his compassion through sharing the gospel and serving others. Pray that individually and collectively the body of Christ will forsake sin and turn to God in rigtheousness.

THURSDAY

Remember the penny prayer we were taught. Thank God for the world of his making. Thank God for leaders of nations and the people they lead. Pray that God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Ask God to stir the world and events in our present world to the direction of his will. When the righreous is in authority the people rejoice. Pray for the three congregations and Sessions that God will direct and lead in every step of the process.

One way to focus and fuel your prayer life is to use different prayer themes.

Sunday Prayer Theme: Your Church

Monday Prayer Theme: Thanksgiving

Tuesday Prayer Focus: Your Family

Wednesday Prayer Topic: The Nations

Pray that God would save multitudes worldwide, that the gospel would go forth in power to every nation and people.

Thursday Prayer Theme: Your City and Region

Friday Prayer Focus: Salvation

Make a list of all your family members, friends, neighbors, schoolmates and co-workers who are unsaved and ask Jesus to save each one.
