

SUNDAY

Sunday after Sunday as we gather to worship, we do so in faith we never worship alone but in company with God's people in heaven and on earth. Please pray for Stanley, our organist, the video, and audio crew as Sunday by Sunday, they lead us in worship bringing to life the presence and promises God.

MONDAY

The Church is praying around the world. No problem is too big or small for our sovereign God. Thank God for the world of his making. Pray for all the countries that are going through conflict and political instability. Pray particularly for Ukraine and Russia; pray for peace, and that their citizens be free from fear and know stability once more. Many countries are crying out for mercy. Lord, we entrust them to your sovereign care, and we too pray for Your compassion and provision.

TUESDAY

Lent is the 40 day period where we draw closer to God in the lead up to Easter. In this Lenten season ask God to strengthen us against the temptations of the devil, and remove from us all lust and every unrighteousness, and shield us against our foes, seen and unseen. Pray that God would make our mind steadfast in his will and aware of our soul's need.

WEDNESDAY

Mental health problems affect us all in some way, either directly or through the pain of someone we know and love. 1 in 4 of us are emotionally unwell at any one time. Pray that the stigma of mental illness may be broken down. Pray that those struggling with mental health may be met with love and acceptance and that it will begin with us.

THURSDAY

Meeting and discusions amongst St Andrew's, Auld Kirk, and St Columba miniters has began in view to develop a mission plan as we prepare to become one in the future. Sessions of the three congregations will meet at some point soon. As we meet pray that God will move within and among us. Opening our ears to hear his joyous laughter and still small voice. Opening our eyes to see the wonderful and surprising possibilities of his Kingdom. Opening our minds that we would know the wisdom of Kingdom living. Opening our hearts to experience his abundant and overflowing love. Opening our souls to see Christ in friend and stranger.

FRIDAY

The Steering Group for the formation of the Presbytery of the South West of Scotland has been working relentlessly. Pray for everyone involved. The Presbytery will encompass a very diverse landscape literally and will become one of the largest Presbyteries. Pray for the development Process of this new Presbytery.
